

## The Grace of God in the Epistles

Rom 5:2 – Standing grace - we stand cemented in the grace of God. This speaks of our position

Rom 5:20 – Abounding grace – grace abounds where the offence and sin abounds

Rom 5:21 - Reigning grace - grace reigns over death

Rom 12:3 – Grace thinking – grace to think properly about ourselves

Rom 12:6 - Gifting grace – grace gives us one or more spiritual gifts

1 Cor 3:10 – Building grace – grace was given to Paul to build the church

1 Cor 15:9-11 (10) – Enabling and Being grace – grace made Paul what he was and enabled

2 Cor 4:15 – Abundant Grace – grace enables all things to be for your sakes so that God gets the glory

2 Cor 6:1 – Working Grace – as workers don't receive the grace of God in vain

2 Cor 8:6 – Grace giving – grace to give

2 Cor 8:9 – Enriching Grace – though Jesus was rich by grace He became poor that we might become rich

2 Cor 12:9 – Strengthening Grace – grace was sufficient for Paul and made him strong when he was weak

2 Cor 9:8 All Grace – God is able to make all grace abound toward us that we have sufficiency to abound in every good work

Gal 1:6 – Called into Grace – the Galatians were called into grace

Gal 1:15 – Called by Grace – God called Paul by grace from his mother's womb

Eph 1:6 Accepting Grace – grace has made us accepted in the beloved

Eph 1:7 Redeeming and Forgiving Grace – grace has given us redemption and forgiveness

Eph 2:5,8; Titus 2:11 – Saving Grace – we are saved by grace

Eph 2:7 – Riches of Grace – in the ages to come God will show us the exceeding riches of His grace

Eph 3:2 – Dispensation of Grace – Paul was given a dispensation (responsibility) of grace to be extended toward the Ephesians

Eph 3:8 – Preaching Grace – Paul was given grace to preach to the gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ

Eph 4:7 – Measure of Grace – we have the grace needed to express our spiritual gift/s

Eph 4:29 – Grace Speech – speech that edifies the hearer

Col 3:16 – Singing Grace – grace to sing unto the Lord in our hearts

Col 4:6 – Grace Speech – letting our speech be gracious and seasoned with salt

2 Thess 2:16 – Comfort and Hoping Grace – God has given us an everlasting consolation and hope through grace

Titus 3:7 – Justifying Grace – we are justified by grace

Heb 4:16 – Throne of Grace – we are admonished to boldly approach the throne of grace to obtain mercy and find grace to help in times of need

Heb 12:28 – Serving Grace – since we have received a kingdom, which can't be moved let us, have grace to serve God acceptably

Heb 13:9 - Establishing Grace – it's good for the heart to be established with grace, not with false doctrine and food

Js 4:6; 1 Pet 5:5 – Grace for the humble – God gives grace to the humble person

1 Pet 1:13 – Revelation Grace – grace is revealed when Jesus returns

1 Pet 4:10 – The Manifold Grace of God – be good stewards of the manifold grace of God

1 Pet 5:10 – God of all Grace – we are called by the God of all grace

2 Pet 3:18 – Growing Grace – grace to grow in our walk with God
