8. Christ Will Return for The Believer (the Rapture)- John 14:3; 1 Corinthians 15:51-58; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
9. Justified (declared righteous): Rom. 3:24, 28; 4:5; 5:1, 9; 8:30, 33; 1 Cor. 6:11; Gal. 2:16; 3:8, 11, 24; Titus 3:7.
10. Redeemed (The deliverance from the bondage of sin on the basis of the payment of a ransom): Rom. 3:24; Gal. 3:13; 4:4; Eph. 1:7; Col. 1:14; Hebrews 9:12; 1 Pet. 1:18; Rev. 5:9
11. Every believer receives propitiation for sins (the turning away of the wrath of God because of the offering of Christ): Rom. 3:25-26; Ephesians 5:2; 1 John 2:2; 4:10.
12. All sins are judged by the substitutionary spiritual death of Christ on the cross: (Jesus Christ taking our place to bear the punishment from God the Father for our sins)
Luke 22:19-20; John 10:15; Rom. 4:25; 5:6, 8; 1 Cor. 11:24; 15:3; 2 Cor. 5:21; Gal. 3:13; Eph 1:7; 1 Tim. 2:6; Titus 2:14; Heb. 2:9; 1 Pet. 2:21; 3:18; 4:1
 - a. This includes our sins being imputed to Christ- (Isa. 53:5-6, 11; 2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Pet. 2:24
 - b. Having the righteousness of God (Romans 4:6) and our sins being imputed to Christ (Romans 4:25) and judged by Him, the believer's sins will no longer be imputed to the believer (Romans 4:8).
13. Stand forever in a State of Grace- Romans 5:2 (Perfect Tense)
14. The believer has Hope- Romans 5:2; Galatians 5:5; Ephesians 4:4; Col. 1:5, 27; 2 Thess. 2:16; Titus 1:2, 2:13; 3:7; 1 Peter 1:3

15. Within the “Much More” Grace Care of the Father and the Son: Rom. 5:9–10. We are
 - a. Objects of His love: Eph. 2:4; 5:2; Romans 5:2; 8:35-39
 - b. Objects of His grace
 - (1) For salvation: Romans 3:24; Eph. 2:8–9;
 - (2) For keeping: Rom. 5:2; 1 Pet. 1:5;
 - (3) For service: John 17:18; Rom 6:22; Eph. 4:7;
 - (4) For instruction: Titus 2:12;
 - c. Objects of His power: Eph. 1:19; Phil. 2:13;

16. Reconciled (Christ bringing God and man together because the barrier of sin has been removed)
 - a. By God: 2 Cor. 5:18–19; Col. 1:20-21;
 - b. To God: Rom. 5:10; 2 Cor. 5:20; Eph. 2:14–17.

17. Dead to Old Life (old sin nature), but alive to God (retroactive positional truth). He is
 - a. Crucified with Christ: Rom. 6:6; Gal. 2:20;
 - b. Dead with Christ: Rom. 6:8; Col. 3:3; 1 Pet. 2:24;
 - c. Buried with Christ: Rom. 6:4; Col. 2:12;
 - d. Raised with Christ: Rom. 6:4; 7:4; Eph. 2:6; Col. 2:12; 3:1.
 - e. Seated with Christ: Ephesians 2:6
 - f. Hidden with Christ- (kept safe) Colossians 3:3

18. Given a New Nature- (a new disposition toward God that is bent toward holiness) Romans 7:22; 2 Cor. 3:3; 2 Peter 1:4; 1 John 3:9

19. Positionally Delivered from The Power Of The Sin Nature (an old disposition that is inherited from Adam and is bent toward sin) Rom. 8:2; Phil. 3:3; Col. 2:11 (spiritual circumcision)

20. Adopted by God (placed as adult sons because of positional truth): Rom. 8:15; 8:23 (future); Galatians 4:5; Eph. 1:5.

21. Receives a Human Spirit- (that immaterial part of man designed by God to store, understand and use Scripture and enable the believer to have fellowship with God) Rom. 8:16; 1 Cor. 2:12; 2 Cor. 7:13; Hebrews 4:12; 1 Thess. 5:23; Jude 19

22. Given a Divine Purpose- Ephesians 1:1; 3:7-8; Romans 8:28; 12:1-2; 1 Thessalonians 4:3; 2 Peter 1:9-11

23. Possessing Every Spiritual Blessing in Christ- Eph. 1:3

24. In the Eternal Plan of God (shares the destiny of Christ 1 Peter 2:4); (In Christ-Eph 1:4). He is
- Foreknown: προγινώσκω *proginōskō* to know beforehand (2 Peter 3:17) not necessary to choose beforehand; Rom. 8:29 (to be conformed to the image of His Son); 1 Pet. 1:2;
 - Elected: ἐκλεκτός *eklektós* (for sanctification or service) Rom. 8:33; Col. 3:12; 1 Thess. 1:4 (corporate for service-vs. 3); Titus 1:1; 1 Pet. 1:2;
 - Predestined: προορίζω *proorizō* to determine beforehand (predetermined purpose) Rom. 8:29–30; Eph. 1:5, 11;
 - Chosen: **ἐκλεκτός** *eklektós* (appointed to an office or responsibility) Ephesians 1:4; John 15:16
 - Called: **καλέω** *kaléō* At the point of Salvation God gave each believe a divine purpose for service 1 Thess. 5:24; Romans 1:1, 6, 7
 - Called to be holy- 1 Peter 1:15
 - Called to proclaim his virtue- 1 Peter 2:9
 - Called to suffer for Christ's sake- 1 Peter 2:20-21
 - Called to bring blessing to others- 1 Peter 3:8-9
 - Called to glory and virtue- 2 Peter 1:3
 - Called to fellowship with God's Son- 1 Cor. 1:9
 - Called us to peace with one another- 1 Corinthians 7:15
 - Called to liberty- Galatians 5:13
25. Made Acceptable to God: Eph. 1:6; He is
- Made righteous (imputation): Rom. 3:22; 4:3-8, 24; 1 Cor. 1:30; 2 Cor. 5:21; Phil. 3:9;
 - Sanctified positionally: 1 Cor. 1:2; 30; 6:11; Eph. 1:1; Hebrews 10:10, 14; Jude 1
 - Perfected forever: Heb. 10:14;
26. Forgiven all Sins- Ephesians 1:7; 4:32; Col. 1:14; 2:13; 3:13; 1 John 2:12. A distinction is necessary here between the complete and abiding judicial forgiveness and the oft-repeated forgiveness within the family of God (1 John 1:9).
27. Beneficiary of an Inheritance as Children of God: Rom. 8:17a; Gal. 3:29; 4:7; Eph. 1:11, 14; Col. 1:12; Heb. 9:15; 1 Pet. 1:4. This is not to be confused with the additional inheritance given as a reward based on our works- Acts 20:32; Romans 8:17b; Col. 3:23-24; Hebrews 1:14; 6:12; James 2:5; Rev. 2:26; 3:21; 21:7. There is also a possibility of not receiving the second inheritance by failure to persevere while still having the first inheritance- 1 Cor. 6:11; 2 Timothy 2:12; Galatians 5:21; Ephesians 5:5
28. Recipient of the Ministries of the Holy Spirit.
- Born of the Spirit: John 3:5–8;
 - Baptized with the Spirit: Acts 1:5; 1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27; Eph.4:5
 - Indwelt by the Spirit: John 7:39; Rom. 5:5; 8:9; 1 Cor. 2:12; 3:16; 6:19; 2 Cor. 1:21; Gal. 4:6; 1 John 3:24;
 - Sealed by the Spirit: 2 Cor. 1:22; Eph. 1:13; 4:30;
 - Given spiritual gifts: Romans 12:3-8; 1 Cor. 12:11, 27–31; 13:1–2; Ephesians 4:7-11
29. Guaranteed a Resurrection Body Forever: Romans 8:30; 1 Cor. 15:40–54; Ephesians 1:14 (redemption of our body- Romans 8:23)
30. We are God's inheritance- Ephesians 1:18
31. Receives the Unique Availability of Divine Power: Acts 1:8; 4:33; 2 Cor. 4:7; 6:7; 12:9; 2 Pet. 1:3; Ephesians 1:19-20; 3:7, 16, 20; 6:10; Colossians 1:11, 29; 2 Peter 1:3

32. Every Believer has a New Position in Christ: Eph. 2:6. We are
- a. Partners with Christ in life: Col. 3:4;
 - b. Partners with Christ in service: 1 Cor. 1:9
 - (1) Workers together with God: 1 Cor. 3:9; 2 Cor. 6:1;
 - (2) Servants of the New Covenant: 2 Cor. 3:6;
 - (3) Ambassadors: 2 Cor. 5:20;
 - (4) Living epistles: 2 Cor. 3:3;
 - (5) Servants of God: 2 Cor. 6:4.
33. Gives us all Things that Pertain to Life and Godliness-the believer has great potential for godliness- Ephesians 2:10; 2 Peter 1:3; (makes available the armor)- Eph 6:11
34. Brought Near- Ephesians 2:13 (With this there is a corresponding experience; see James. 4:8; Heb. 10:22)
35. Free from the Mosaic Law.
- a. John 1:17 new dispensation (under grace)
 - b. Acts 15:5, 10, 11, 24, 28, 29 (law-vs. 10, grace-vs. 11-14, kingdom- vs. 15-17)
 - c. Romans 6:14 not under law but under grace
 - d. Romans 7:4 dead to the law
 - e. Romans 7:6 delivered means to take from the sphere of operation
 - f. Romans 8:2 free from the law
 - g. Romans 10:4 end of the law
 - h. 1 Cor. 9:20-23 under law toward Christ
 - i. 2 Corinthians 3:6-13 passing away
 - j. Galatians 3:19 law only till the seed (Christ)
 1. Justification could never come by keeping the law (Gal. 2:16; Rom. 3:20)
 2. Sanctification does not come by keeping the law (Gal. 5:1-4; Heb. 7:18, 19)
 - k. Gal. 3:10; 5:1-4; Heb. 10:28-29 The church age believer is warned about going back under the law
 - l. Gal. 5:24-25 No longer under a tutor
 - m. Ephesians 2:14-16 abolished means to put out of business; to dissolve business relationships
 - n. Our guilt from the Law (Romans 2:13) paid by Christ- Col. 2:13
 - o. Hebrews 7:11-12 change means abrogation or removal
 - p. Hebrews 8:13- obsolete and ready to disappear
36. Guaranteed a Heavenly Citizenship Based on Reconciliation: Luke 10:20; Eph. 2:14-19; Phil. 3:20
37. Every Believer is Appointed A Priest unto God. We are
- a. A holy priesthood: 1 Pet. 2:5, 9;
 - b. A royal priesthood: 1 Pet. 2:9; Rev. 1:6.
38. Connected to Other Believers- Romans 12:5; 1 Cor. 12:12, 14, 18; Gal. 6:10; Ephesians 2:19; 3:6, 15; 4:25
39. On a Secure Foundation- 1 Cor. 3:11; Eph. 2:20

40. The believer has put off the old man- (old identity)- Eph. 4:22; Col. 3:9
41. The believer has put on the new man- (new identity)- Eph. 4:24; Col. 3:10
42. Given Access to God: Rom. 5:2; Eph. 2:18; 3:12; Heb. 4:14-16; 10:19–20
43. United with the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We are
- a. In God: 1 Thess. 1:1; cf., “God in you,” Eph. 4:6;
 - b. In Christ: John 14:20; Eph. 1:3; cf., “Christ in you,” Col. 1:27;
 - (1) A member in His Body: Romans 12:4-5; 1 Cor. 10:17; 12:12-14, 18, 20; Ephesians 2:16; 4:4; Col. 3:15
 - (2) A branch in the Vine: John 15:5;
 - (3) A stone in the Building: Eph. 2:21–22; 1 Pet. 2:5;
 - (4) A sheep in the Flock: John 10:27–29;
 - (5) A portion of His Bride: 2 Cor. 11:2; Eph. 5:25–27; Rev. 19:6–8, 21:9;
 - (6) A priest of the kingdom of priests: 1 Pet. 2:9;
 - (7) A new spiritual species: 2 Cor. 5:17;
 - c. In the Holy Spirit: Rom. 8:9; “the Spirit in you.”
44. Delivered from the Kingdom of Satan: Ephesians 5:8; Col. 1:13a; 2:15
45. Light in the Lord (part of the angelic conflict): Eph. 5:8; 1 Thess. 5:4–5.
46. Filled with the Holy Spirit at the Moment of Salvation: Gal. 3:3.
 The filling of the Holy Spirit received at salvation is revoked when the believer sins. The filling of the Holy Spirit is recovered when the believer confesses his sin (1 John 1:9).
 Ephesians 5:18
47. Name Written in The Book Of Life- Philippians 4:3; Rev. 3:5; 21:27
48. The believer becomes a legal heir of the kingdom by *de jure* even though the Kingdom has not yet occurred- Col. 1:13b.
49. Complete in Christ- Col. 2:10.
50. Exempt from Tribulational Wrath- 1 Thess. 5:9; Rev. 3:10
